


Denmead Brass - Safeguarding Flow Chart

Denmead Brass takes the safeguarding of all its members seriously. Our full safeguarding policy can be viewed via our website www.denmeadbrass.org.uk

Safeguarding is everyone's responsibility. If you have a safeguarding concern or someone makes a disclosure to you, you must take action immediately.



- Reassure the child/ person making the disclosure that telling someone about it was the right thing to do.
- Tell him/her that you now must do what you can to keep him/her (or the child who is the subject of the allegation) safe.
- Let him/her know what you are going to do next and who else needs to know about it.
- Let him/her tell their whole story. Don't try to investigate or quiz them, but make sure that you are clear as to what he/she is saying.

Make a written record of your concerns taking note of the date, and your name and position. The safeguarding leader will then contact Hampshire children's social care to report the concern.
